New Leaders to Address Crisis Facing California Schools *Media Availability by Phone*

Newly elected CFT President Joshua Pechthalt and Secretary-Treasurer Jeff Freitas will address key issues in the crisis facing California public education. Amidst national attacks on teachers and other public employees' right to bargain collectively, to receive modest retirement benefits, and with California school districts issuing thousands of layoff notices, the new leaders will hold their first media availability.

Pechthalt taught at Manual Arts High School in L.A. Unified School District for 21 years. "Teachers and school employees are determined to build a movement to defend public education and social services. Our students deserve an education more than billionaires deserve tax breaks," said Pechthalt.

Freitas, who attended West Point before gaining his B.A. and Masters in Education from UC Santa Barbara, taught in Carpinteria and most recently served as a CFT lobbyist. Freitas said, "20,000 teachers have been given pink slips. That means record-high class sizes will only become worse. We must address the financial crisis that is harming students, and we will help lead that effort."

The two announced a news teleconference on Thursday to outline their vision for the fight against attacks on education funding, worker rights, pensions and jobs, and the way to turn California public education around.
