**San Diego Educators And Community Allies Outline Impact
Of Budget Cuts, Call For Fair Tax Solutions**

Board members, classroom teachers and professors, students and parents, will detail the dire personal and social impact of \$18 billion in state education cuts and what the future will hold for local education if progressive tax solutions are not found for California's budget and educational crisis.
