
RE: California Federation of Teachers Member Survey on In-person Learning

The following summarizes key takeaways from recent research among California Federation of Teachers (CFT) members regarding issues related to the COVID-19 pandemic and reopening.


California educators and classified professionals are eager to get vaccinated and prioritize reopening campuses provided that basic safety measures are in place to protect students and staff.

• The vast majority of educators and classified professionals who make up CFT are willing to get vaccinated, with 87% agreeing they will get a vaccine as soon as one is available to them.



 CFT members prioritize a number of safety measures surrounding a safe return to campus, including access to vaccines, ventilation plans, adequate supplies of PPE, regular testing, and distancing.

Methodology

The findings in this memo come from a mixed mode live telephone, email-to-web, and text-to-web survey conducted January 28 – February 5, 2021 by EMC Research among 1,217 active CFT members. Telephone interviews were conducted by trained, professional interviewers; landlines and mobile phones included. Email and text invitations were sent with a link to the web survey. Oversamples were conducted among members in the Council of Classified Employees and University Council-AFT divisions. The results have an effective margin of error of \pm 3.23 percentage points.
