About the scholarship program

The scholarships were established in honor of former CFT President Raoul Teilhet, the charismatic leader of the union during the 1970s when California education employees won collective bargaining.

About the scholarship awards

Scholarships of \$3000 are awarded to students entering or attending a four-year university; \$1000 scholarships are awarded to students entering or attending a two-year school. The awards are based on academic achievement, financial need, special talents and skills, participation in extracurricular activities, and a 500-word essay on a social issue about which the applicant feels strongly.

Who is eligible to apply?

Scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors and continuing college students who are children or dependents of CFT members in good standing, or children of deceased CFT members. High school seniors who received a Raoul Teilhet Scholarship are not eligible to apply for a continuing college scholarship.

CFT Raoul Teilhet Scholarship Program

The CFT offers \$3000 and \$1000 scholarships to high school seniors and continuing college students who are dependents of CFT members. Application deadlines: December 15, 2024 and June 15, 2025.

AFT Robert G. Porter Scholarship Program

The AFT awards four-year \$8000 scholarships to four high school seniors who are dependents of AFT members, as well as 10 one-time education grants of \$1000 to AFT members. Application deadline: March 31, 2025.
