News Conference Prior to Oral Arguments in Appeal of Flawed *Vergara* Ruling

Civil Rights Icon Dolores Huerta, Educators, Lead Attorney to Speak Thursday; Media Teleconference Following Oral Arguments

LOS ANGELES —Labor leader and civil rights icon Dolores Huerta will join educators and community members for a news conference Thursday morning, immediately prior to oral arguments before the 2nd District California Court of Appeal in *Vergara v. California*. The <u>California Teachers Association</u> and the <u>California Federation of Teachers</u> are interveners in the case and, along with <u>Attorney General Kamala Harris</u>, are seeking reversal of a deeply flawed lower court ruling that strikes down statutes protecting teachers from arbitrary firings, providing transparency in layoff decisions and supporting due-process rights.

Educators, Huerta and fellow supporters will explain why this case is extremely harmful for students as well as teachers, and how the laws under assault work well in school districts all over the state to ensure children have quality teachers in their classrooms. Attorney Michael Rubin, who will argue the case before the Court, will discuss the litany of reversible errors in the earlier ruling. *Vergara* was initiated by millionaire David Welch and a high-powered public relations firm, and is backed by corporate "reformers" and anti-teacher forces.
